Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.

- Turn two ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the LEFT UPRIGHT (D).
- Fasten the LEFT CABINET RAIL (2) to the LEFT UPRIGHT (D). Use three BLACK 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (26).






Turn the LEFT UPRIGHT (D) over.

- Separate the EXTENSION SLIDES (II and KK) from the EXTENSION RAILS (HH and JJ) as shown in the enlarged diagram below. Be prepared, the parts are greasy.
- Fasten the EXTENSION RAILS (HH and JJ) to the LEFT UPRIGHT (D). Use six BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (25).
- NOTE: For each EXTENSION RAIL, turn a SCREW into the hole shown in the enlarged diagram. Then, slide the inner cartridge of the EXTENSION RAIL out to find the other two holes that line up with the holes in the UPRIGHT. Turn a SCREW into those holes.
- **NOTE**: The EXTENSION SLIDES will be used later for the DRAWERS.

- Turn two ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the LEFT UPRIGHT (D).
- Insert two WOOD DOWELS (12) into the LEFT UPRIGHT (D).

Use these holes.

Pull up or down on the black lever and pull the SLIDE from the RAIL.






Turn two ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the RIGHT UPRIGHT (C).


- Fasten the RIGHT CABINET RAIL (1) to the RIGHT UPRIGHT (C). Use three BLACK 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (26).
- Turn the RIGHT UPRIGHT (C) over and turn four ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the RIGHT UPRIGHT.
- Insert two WOOD DOWELS (12) into the RIGHT UPRIGHT (C).




- Insert four HIDDEN CAMS (8) into the holes in the SHELF (H) as shown.
- Fasten the SHELF (H) to the UPRIGHTS (C and D). Tighten four HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SHELF insert into the holes in the UPRIGHTS.



Fasten the SMALL BACK (G) to the SMALL SHELF (L).

- Use two BLACK 1-1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (19).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SMALL SHELF insert into the holes in the SMALL BACK.
- Fasten the RIGHT BOTTOM (I) to the SMALL BACK (G). Use two BLACK 1-1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (19).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SMALL BACK insert into the holes in the RIGHT BOTTOM.







Insert six HIDDEN CAMS (8) into the exact holes shown in the SMALL BACK (G) and BOTTOMS (I and J).



- Fasten the SMALL BACK (G) and BOTTOMS (I and J) to the UPRIGHTS (C and D). Tighten six HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SMALL BACK and BOTTOMS insert into the holes in the UPRIGHTS.




- Turn six ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the TOP (E).
- Insert six WOOD DOWELS (12) into the TOP (E).
- Fasten the TOP MOLDING (M) to the TOP (E). Use four BLACK 1-1/16" WAFER HEAD SCREWS (29).






- Insert six HIDDEN CAMS (8) into the UPRIGHTS (C and D) and SMALL BACK (G) as shown.
- Fasten the TOP (E) to the UPRIGHTS (C and D) and SMALL BACK (G). Tighten six HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the UPRIGHTS and SMALL BACK insert into the holes in the TOP.




Fasten the EXTENSION RAILS (HH and JJ) to the LEFT END (B). Use six BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (25).

NOTE: For each EXTENSION RAIL, turn a SCREW into the hole shown in the enlarged diagram. Then, slide the inner cartridge of the EXTENSION RAIL out to find the other two holes that line up with the holes in the END. Turn a SCREW into those holes.



Turn four ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the LEFT END (B).







- Insert four HIDDEN CAMS (8) into the TOP (E) and LEFT BOTTOM (J) as shown.
- Fasten the LEFT END (B) to the TOP (E) and LEFT BOTTOM (J). Tighten four HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the TOP and LEFT BOTTOM insert into the holes in the LEFT END.
- Fasten the TOP MOLDING (M) to the LEFT END (B). Use two BLACK 9/16" WAFER HEAD SCREWS (23).



Insert six HIDDEN CAMS (8) into the TOP (E), SMALL Į BACK (G), and RIGHT BOTTOM (I) as shown.

Fasten the RIGHT END (A) to the TOP (E), SMALL BACK (G), Ţ and RIGHT BOTTOM (I). Tighten six HIDDEN CAMS.







- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the TOP, SMALL BACK, Ŧ and RIGHT BOTTOM insert into the holes in the RIGHT END.
- Fasten the TOP MOLDING (M) to the RIGHT END (A). Use two Ţ BLACK 9/16" WAFER HEAD SCREWS (23).



- Turn fifteen ANGLED HEAD CAM SCREWS (9) into the exact holes shown in the BACK (F).
- Insert seventeen WOOD DOWELS (12) into the exact holes shown in the BACK (F).



- Insert fifteen HIDDEN CAMS (8) into the LEFT END (B), UPRIGHTS (C and D), TOP (E), SHELVES (H and L), and Į BOTTOMS (I and J) as shown.
- Fasten the BACK (F) to the LEFT END (B), UPRIGHTS (C and D) TOP (E), SHELVES (H and L), and BOTTOMS (I and J). Ţ Tighten fifteen HIDDEN CAMS using the ASSEMBLY TOOL (28).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the BACK insert into the holes in the LEFT END, UPRIGHTS, TOP, SHELVES, Ţ and BOTTOMS.

Push the LEGS (N and O) onto the STRETCHER (P).






- Turn fourteen STRAIGHT HEAD CAM SCREWS (11) into the DRAWER FRONTS (R, X, and CC).
- Push fourteen SMALL HIDDEN CAMS (10) into the large holes in the DRAWER SIDES (S, T, Y, Z, DD, and EE) and PENCIL DRAWER BRACE (W).










- Fasten the FILE DRAWER BACK (FF) to the FILE DRAWER SIDES (DD and EE). Use four BLACK 1-1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (19).
- NOTE: Be sure the FILE DRAWER BOTTOM (GG) inserts into the groove of the FILE DRAWER BACK (FF).

Fasten the KNOB (15) to the FILE DRAWER FRONT (CC). Use a BLACK 7/8" MACHINE SCREW (22).

- Fasten the FRONT FILE HANGER (7) to the FILE DRAWER FRONT (CC). Use three BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (25). Į
- Fasten the LONG EXTENSION SLIDES (II) to the FILE DRAWER SIDES (DD and EE). Use six BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD Į SCREWS (25).


- Fasten the KNOB (15) to the DRAWER FRONT (X). Use a BLACK 7/8" MACHINE SCREWS (22).
- Fasten the EXTENSION SLIDES (KK) to the DRAWER SIDES (Y and Z). Use six BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (25).





Fasten the PENCIL DRAWER SIDES (S and T) to the PENCIL DRAWER FRONT (R) and PENCIL DRAWER BRACE (W). Tighten six SMALL HIDDEN CAMS.




Slide a PENCIL DRAWER BOTTOM (V) into the grooves in the PENCIL DRAWER SIDES (S and T) and PENCIL DRAWER FRONT (R).



- Fasten the PENCIL DRAWER BACK (U) to the PENCIL DRAWER SIDES (S and T) and PENCIL DRAWER BRACE (W). Use six BLACK 1-1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (19).
- NOTE: Be sure the PENCIL DRAWER BOTTOM (V) inserts into the groove of the PENCIL DRAWER BACK



- Fasten the DRAWER SLIDES (3 and 4) to the PENCIL DRAWER SIDES (S and T). Use six BLACK 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (26).
- Fasten two KNOBS (15) to the PENCIL DRAWER FRONT (R). Use two BLACK 7/8" MACHINE SCREWS (22).

- Fasten two HINGES (13) to the DOOR (Q). Use four SILVER 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (27).
- Fasten the KNOB (15) to the DOOR (Q). Use a BLACK 7/8" MACHINE SCREW (22).





Carefully stand your unit upright.

- To insert the pencil drawer into your unit, tip the front of the drawer down and drop the rollers on the drawer behind the rollers on the unit. Lift the front of the drawer up and slide it into the unit.
- To insert the other drawers into your unit, line up the EXTENSION SLIDES on the drawers with the EXTENSION RAILS on the unit and push the drawers into the unit until the drawers are fully inserted. The drawers will push in hard until they are all the way in, then they will slide in and out easier.




Pro Tip: Lift with your legs. And, you know, your arms.

Push the RUBBER SLEEVES over the METAL PINS (18). Insert the METAL PINS into the hole locations of your choice in the RIGHT END (A) and RIGHT UPRIGHT (C). Set the ADJUSTABLE SHELF (K) onto the METAL PINS.



Fasten the DOOR (Q) to the RIGHT END (A). Slide the HINGES (13) onto the HINGE BRACKETS on the RIGHT END.




Secure the DOOR with the mounting screw on the HINGE BRACKET. See the next step for adjustments.



Refer to the enlarged diagram to identify the parts on the HINGES.


- The DOOR may need some adjustments. Follow the text below to make needed adjustments.
- DOOR ADJUSTMENTS: To adjust the DOOR from side to side (horizontal), turn the adjusting screw in or out.
- To adjust the DOOR up and down (vertical), loosen both vertical adjustment screws. Move the DOOR up or down to the desired location. Tighten the screws after making adjustments.
- To adjust the DOOR in or out (depth), loosen the mounting screw one turn and move the DOOR in or out, as needed. Tighten the mounting screw after making adjustments.

- Fasten the BACK (F) to the RIGHT END (A). Use a BLACK 1-1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREW (19).
- Insert the GROMMET (16) into the hole in the TOP (E).



Peel a sticker from the APPLIQUE CARD (17) and place it onto each visible HIDDEN CAM and over the head of each visible SCREW.
