




## Part Identification




While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label or an inked letter on the edge to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.


- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- Fasten the BRACES (D) to one of the FRAMES (C).
  Tighten four 1/2" HEX HEAD SCREWS (7) using the L-WRENCH (3).




Fasten the remaining FRAME (C) to the BRACES (D). Tighten four 1/2" HEX HEAD SCREWS (7) using the L-WRENCH (3).




- Fasten the SHELF (G) to the FRAMES (C). Use six 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (6).
- NOTE: You should start each SCREW a few turns before completely tightening any of them.




- Fasten the ENDS (A and B) to the SHELF (G). Tighten six 1/2" HEX HEAD SCREWS (7) using the L-WRENCH (3).
- NOTE: You should start each SCREW a few turns before completely tightening any of them.



Fasten the BACK BRACE (E) to the ENDS (A and B).
Tighten four 1" MACHINE SCREWS (5) and four NUTS (1) using the WRENCH (4) and a screwdriver.



- Carefully stand your unit upright.
- Peel a GLASS SPACER (2) from the GLASS SPACER CARD (2) and stick them onto the tabs of the FRAMES (C).
- ▼ Place the GLASS TOP (F) with the shiny surface facing up onto the GLASS SPACERS.
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
